### **Pre-Admission Testing Information and Instructions**

Three to five days prior to surgery you will need to go to the hospital for pre-admitting testing. You do not need an appointment and you do not need to restrict your diet for the tests that have been ordered. The instructions are listed below and can be found on the back of your pink patient copy "Pre-admission Testing Form". Use the hospital's main entrance and report to the admitting department. They are open 7 days a week from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm. You may be given your hospital identification bracelet at this time and you will receive instructions on where to report for surgery. Please do not remove your identification bracelet, if given, until after you go home from the hospital. Please bring any papers given to you by your physician, insurance cards and/or forms and any question you have about the hospital. Please allow 1-2 hours for pre-admission and testing. #### **Arrive 2 hours prior to procedure**

##### **Prior to Surgery**

- Testing: Report to the Admitting Dept. for pre-admitting testing 3-5 days before your procedure between 8:00 am and 7:00 pm. Please bring any papers give to you by your physician, insurance cards and/or forms. Allow 1-2 hours. No appointment is necessary.
- If you are not feeling well the night before, or the day of the procedure, please call your physician.
- Do not eat, drink or chew gum after 12:00 midnight the night before your procedure. This includes water, coffee, etc.
- Your assigned anesthesiologist may phone you the night before your procedure or will see you the day of surgery.

##### **Day of Procedure**

- Wear comfortable clothing.
- Leave all jewelry and valuables at home.
- **Someone must be available to drive you home after the procedure. We recommend that your ride stay at the facility during the procedure.**
- **You must have a responsible adult with you for 24 hours after your procedure.**

##### **Bring with You**

- Phone numbers of your pharmacy for any take home medication.
- Your current medications in their original bottles or packaging.
- Your glasses or contacts and case.
